



# **Tracktherace GPS Tracking in TransPyr**

TransPyr 2016 will have use a platform that will help us to know the status of the race in real time. This is http://tracktherace.com platform, with which we have come agreement, so that each one of you, will carry a tracking device that reports your exact position at any time during the race.

A view of the race has been enabled, which will be public and will be accessible on this platform, so organization, family, friends and fans will be able to follow you online at any time, knowing your exact position, the pace you have and could be waiting for you at some course point because they will know at any time where you are. Data from all participants who have chosen to use this service have already been imported into the platform, and within the different options offered, we would point to customize your personal profile. In this section, you can configure your presence on the platform, setting your profile picture, or even including a small text to talk about you.

To enable this service, participants will have to carry during the event an electronic device that will capture and send your position at any moment using the GPS satellites. These devices have very small dimensions (70 mm x 40 mm x 25 mm) and its weight is about 60g, so it will be able to bring in a jersey pocket.

In the delivery of participant documentation, two devices for each participant will be distributed. Each device will have a number, and you must use the device with a smaller number in stages 1, 2 and 3, and the one with greater number in stage 4, 5, 6 and 7. For example if you have devices 0135 and 0216, 0135 would be used in days 1, 2 and 3, and 0216 in days 4, 5, 6 and 7.


Devices will be distributed with a small plastic zip bag, where you should put the device turned on before put it in your pocket. If you wear a backpack, and you place the device in it, it's important that the tracker will be on the top of the backpack, and with the side with lights orientered to the sky.

When you receive the device, you will have to deliver to the organization a deposit of 100€ in cash, which will be recovered when you return both devices with no damage at the end of your participation in TransPyr. The loss or damage of one of the two devices behave the complete loss of the deposit.






The following image describes the management of the tracker, that should be turned on 15 minutes before the start of each stage, and should be turned off when you arrive to the finish line.







### 1) ¿How to turn on the device?

The turn on/turn off button must be pressed during some seconds untill the red light switches on.
Then, the other lights will start to blink.

## 2 ¿When to turn it on?

Device must be turned on at least 15 minutes before the start time.

## 3 ¿How to turn off the device?

The turn on/turn off button must be pressed during some seconds untill the red light starts to blink.

\* The light blinking may last about 90 seconds.

# 4 ¿When to turn it off?

Device must be turned off at least **5 minutes** after the arrival to finish line.

It is very important that you follow these instructions to turn on and off the tracker, and that you ensure once it is turned on, that the lights are still blinking after a few minutes (this is to ensure that you have not pressed the button twice and have on and then off).
